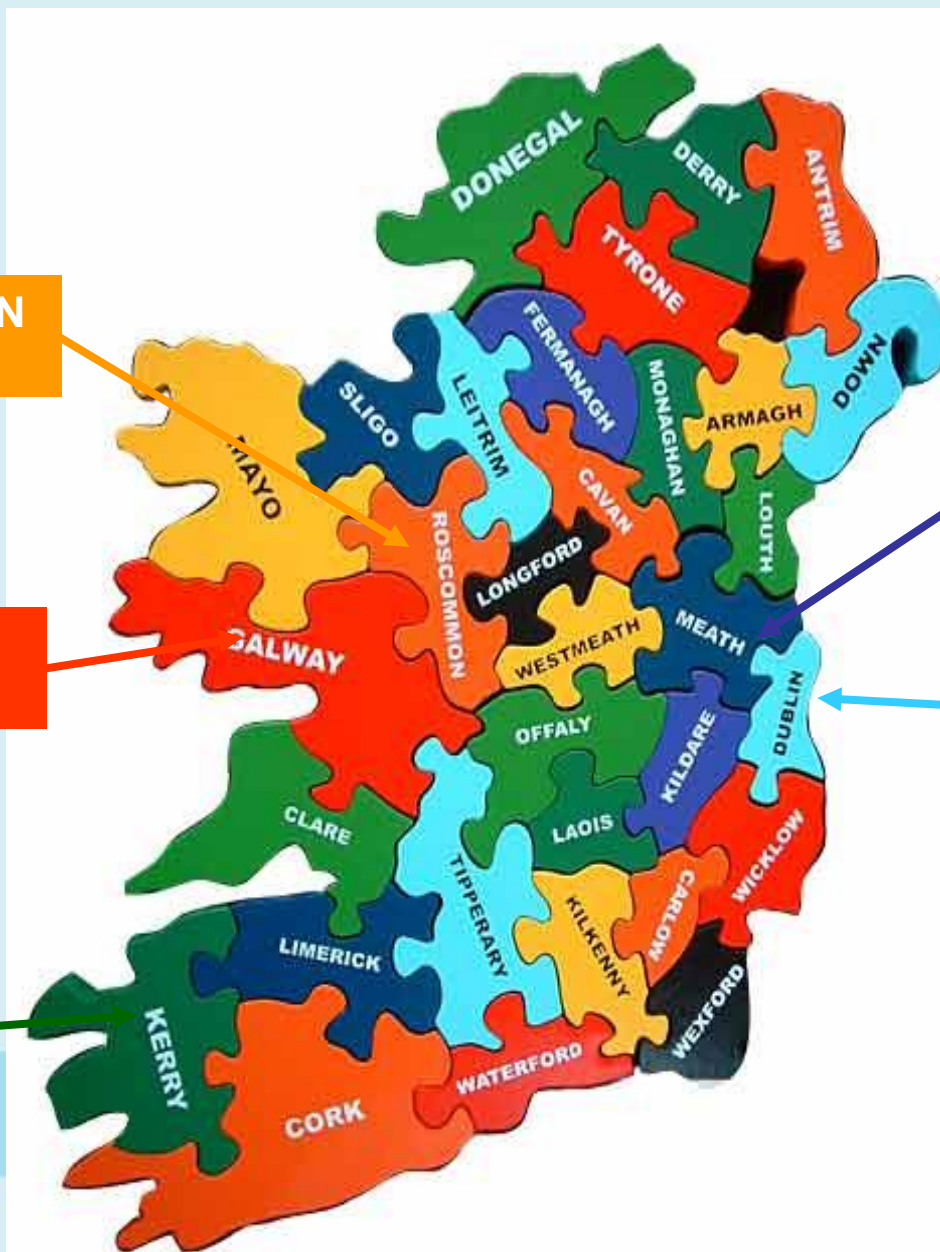

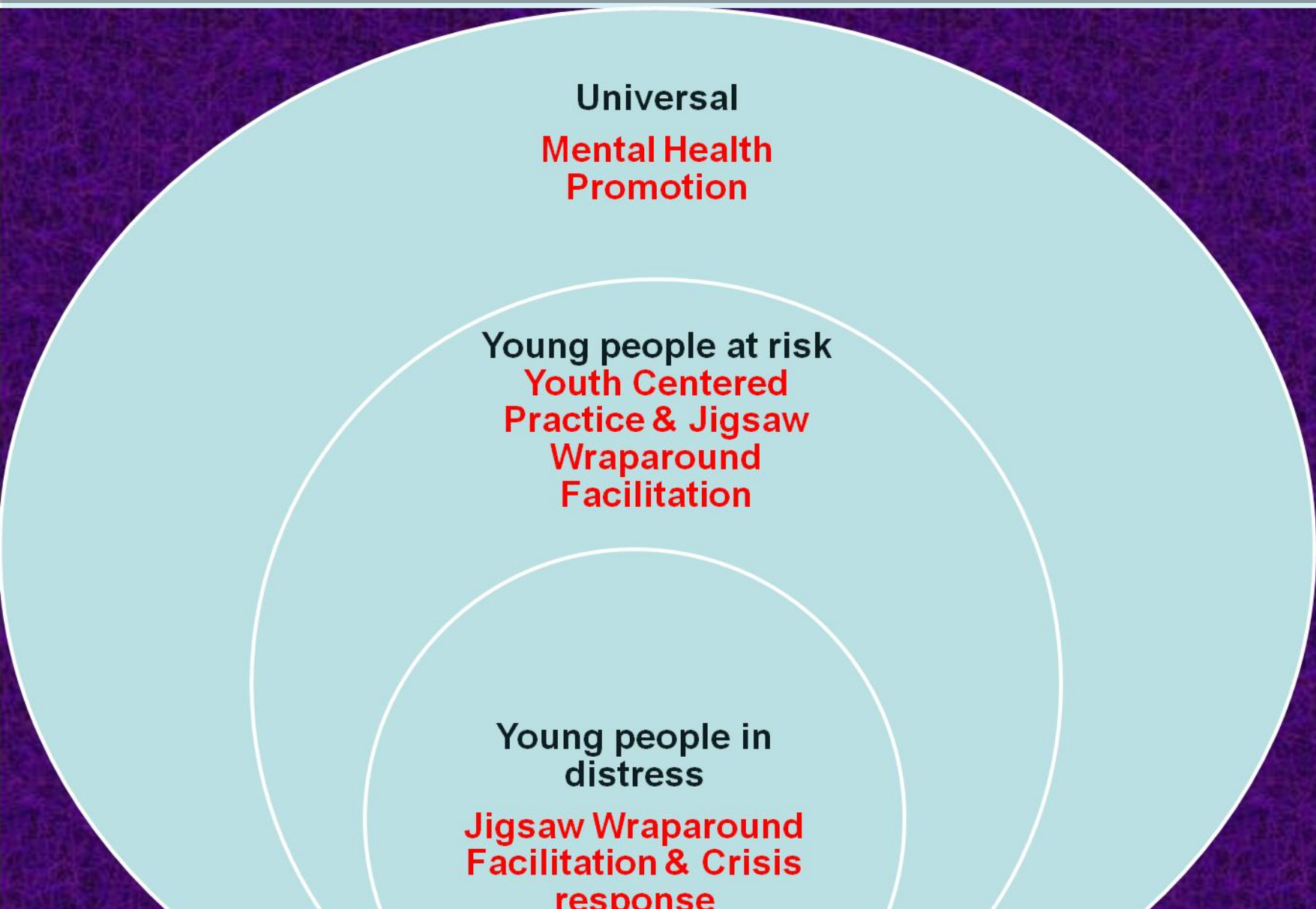

Patricia Byrne has been a volunteer with the Dublin Samaritans since 1996. 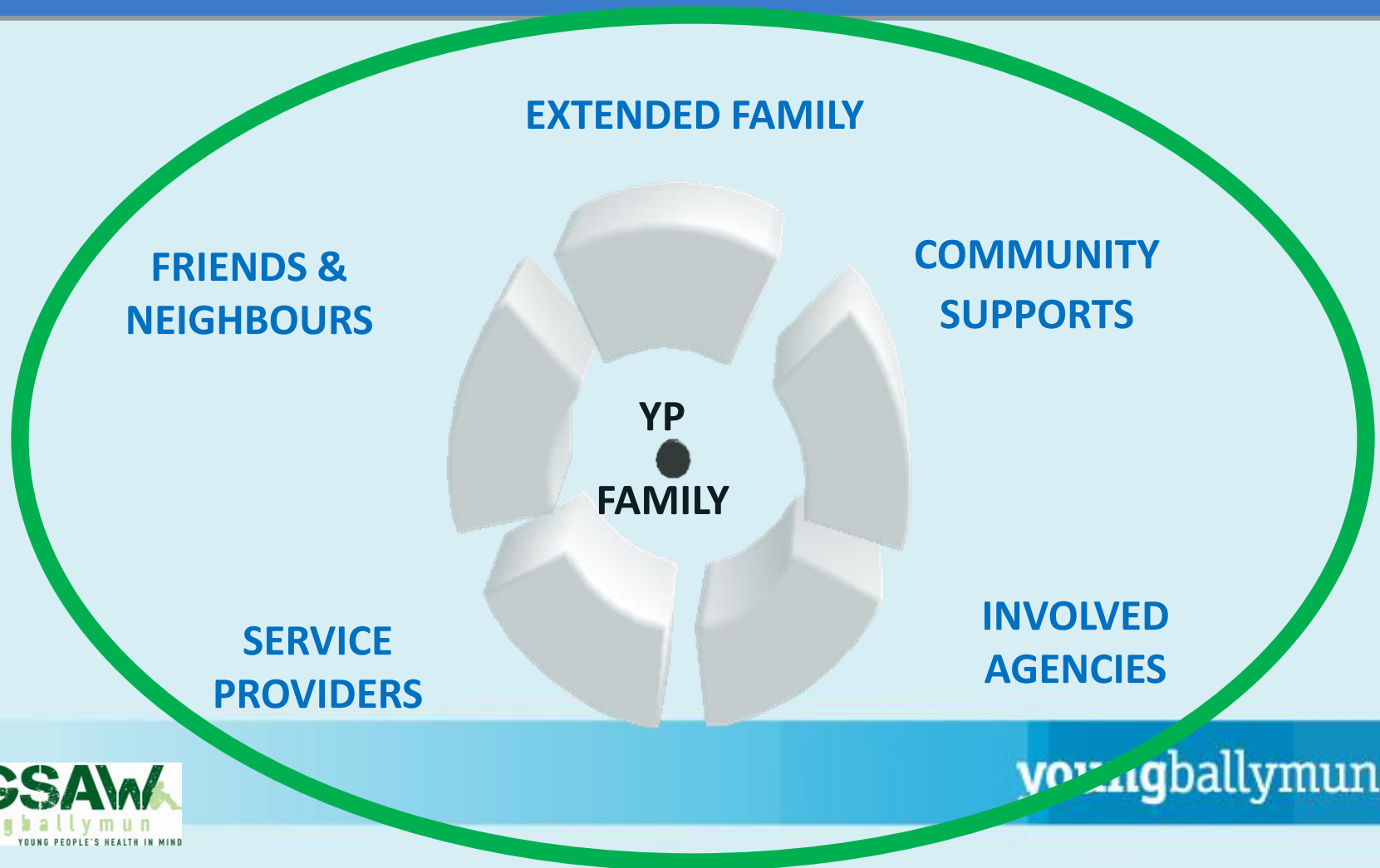
